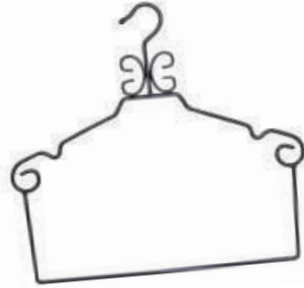

What is My Sister's Closet?

- My Sister's Closet is an outlet for new and gently used women's professional clothing.



- The mission of My Sister's Closet is to provide work force attire to low-income women pursuing employment.
- We are a non-profit 501 (c)(3) charitable organization and depend entirely on volunteers.

Who Qualifies to Use My Sister's Closet?

- Any one can shop and purchase clothing at My Sister's Closet. It's a great place to find affordable business attire!

- Women residing in the Monroe/Owen County area and who are at least 16 years of age may receive free clothing if they are enrolled in a job search program through an approved agency.

How does the Referral System Work?

- To obtain free clothing, qualified women obtain a signed referral form from an approved agency.
- They can then bring the referral form, along with a picture I.D. to My Sister's Closet to select up to 2 outfits for a job interview.
- Once a job is obtained, women may receive up to 3 more outfits.



Volunteer Opportunities

We need volunteers!! There are a variety of ways you can help.

- Fund raising: head up group fund raising event or service opportunity
- Clothing: pickup clothing donations; sort, tag, and hang clothes as they come in
- Alterations: help mend and clean clothes for wear
- Retail: staff the store during hours
- Merchandizing and display: work on store design and layout
- Accounting/bookkeeping: help maintain financial records
- Public relations: create and distribute brochures and flyers, advertising
- Presentations: speak to local community groups
- Correspondence: write letters, make and keep track of phone calls
- Web development: assist with web design and technology needs
- Grants: help research and write grant applications
- Donations: invite potential supporters to donate Monetary/ Gifts In-kind
